

Teacher iPads Quick Start Guide

1. **Not restricted** like Student/Cart iPads are
2. **Managed** through Airwatch
3. Teachers can **install their own Apps**, email accounts, social media accounts, etc
 - Log into District email:
<http://start.sd34.bc.ca/start/set-up-district-email-on-your-ios-device/>
 - The school/district can install Apps directly to iPads. Need to request it via email.
4. Teachers should put a **passcode** on their iPads, especially if they are using Freshgrade
5. **Temporary Restrictions** can easily be set to keep students out of sensitive areas.
 - Go to Settings=>General=>Restrictions and set a passcode (separate than your lock screen passcode)
6. **Guided Access Mode** is very useful when a teacher wants student(s) to stay in one App. Use your QR Code reader to access this article

7. **iPads can dictate** speech to text. Use the microphone icon in any text editing program
8. **iPads can read** selections of text or whole pages. Turn this on in Settings=>General=>Accessibility=>Speech. To read entire pages of an article, drag 2 fingers down from the upper edge of the screen.
